



Adenosine or Persantine Stress Test
Three Village Cardiology

Test Time: 3 hours

Preparation: Check with your doctor to find out if any other medications should be held with these tests. You may not be able to take this type of stress test if you have ASTHMA.

Purpose: This test is performed on patients that who cannot walk on a treadmill. The patient will be injected with a radioisotope and then placed under a special camera for 30 minutes. The patient will then receive an injection of Persantine or Adenosine for 6 minutes, injected again with the isotope, instructed to eat and have pictures taken again in 30 minutes. The patient then will be asked if you are able to WALK on a treadmill briefly.

If you feel you CANNOT WALK AT ALL, please let the technicians know.
